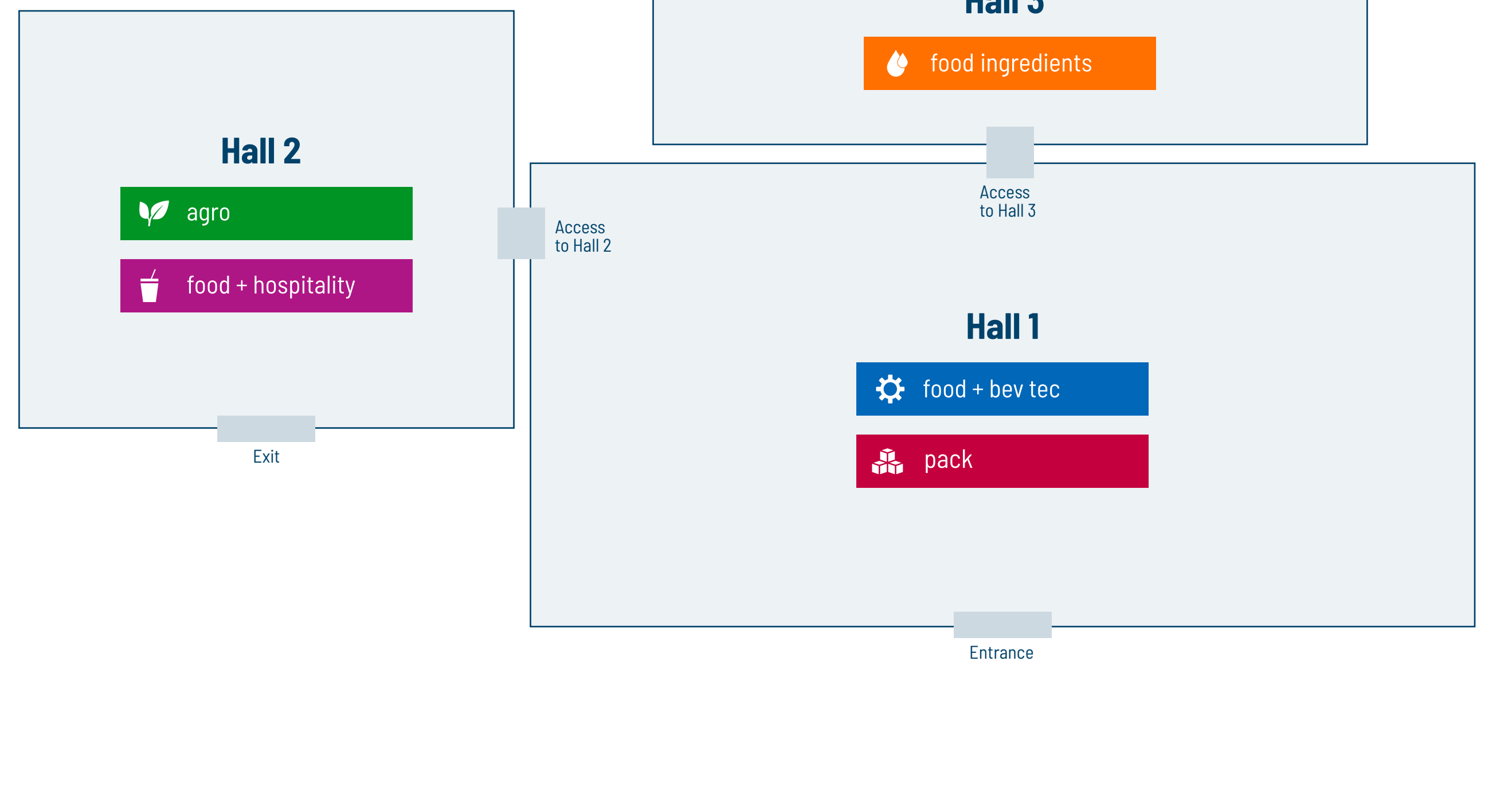

Nigeria and West Africa investing heavily in agro, food, beverage & packaging technology and ingredients

- With imports of food & packaging technology of €304 million in 2023, Nigeria is Africa's second largest importer, after South Africa with €398 million and ahead of Algeria with €296 million and Egypt with €281 million. (VDMA 2024)
- Despite significant investments in local food production, Nigeria's food imports totaled US\$6.1bn in 2023, positioning the nation as one of Africa's foremost food importers. Nigerian food exports made up for US\$2.2bn. (WTO)
